- Prepare pupils for competitions/matches (as appropriate) and encourage pupils to take up opportunities to develop their sport.
- Attend matches or other fixtures, as agreed with the Director of Sport.
- Act in a professional manner, maintaining good order among pupils and safeguarding their health and safety.
- Promote and safeguard the welfare of children according to school.
- Assist with any other reasonable duties as requested by the Director of Sport.
